The human endocrine system modulates several processes of the body by the function of hormones. The endocrine system secretes hormones that control how bodily functions work. Thus, the human endocrine system watches over and coordinates all the systems of the body with the use of hormones.

### Human Endocrine System

The endocrine system is a collection of glands that secrete chemical messages we call hormones. These signals are passed through the blood to arrive at a target organ, which has cells possessing the appropriate receptor. Exocrine glands (not part of the endocrine system) secrete products that are passed outside the body.

The endocrine system is study of the glands of an organism that secrete hormones directly into the circulatory system. The organs through which the life running hormones are secreted are known as endocrine glands or simply ductless glands. The hormone secreting glands are located in different parts of a human body (see the image given below).

The endocrine system is a collection of ductless glands that produce hormones and secrete them into the circulatory system. Endocrine glands work without ducts for carrying secretions towards target organs. Instead, hormones can act as chemical messengers for a large number of cells and tissues simultaneously.

Endocrine System The endocrine system interacts with the nervous system to coordinate and integrate body activities by means of hormones. Endocrine tissues and organs secrete hormone into body fluids (mainly blood and lymph) directly using diffusion.

### The Endocrine System

Unlike exocrine glands (sweat, salivary), endocrine glands secrete their respective substances directly into the bloodstream rather than through a duct. These endocrine glands belong to the body's control system and they produce hormones which help to regulate the functions of cells and tissues.

A hormone is a chemical messenger secreted by an endocrine gland directly into the bloodstream where it travels to a target organ/tissue where it exerts a specific effect.
