A Gnostic Eucharist, called the Fraction du Pain or "Breaking of the Bread" was composed. The sacramental liturgy of the Church was completed by the inclusion of two Cathar sacraments, the Consolamentum and the

Appareillementum.

Related to the above, and perhaps even more important, is the theological distinction that Jones draws between the sacrament of orders and episcopal lineage. After the death of Fabre des Essarts in 1917, the Patriarchate of the Gnostic Church was assumed by Léon Champrenaud (Tau Théophane). Champrenaud was succeeded by Patrice Genty (Tau Basilide) in 1921, who put l'Église Gnostique de France to rest in 1926 in favor of Jean Bricaud's Église Gnostique Universelle.
