No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

### Repair Wallpaper

Varies by wallpaper type. With natural materials, such as grasscloth, slight variations in colors are natural. If the effect is too stark, reversing each strip by hanging every other strip upside down can minimize the problem. Another method is to sort the rolls by tonal values and hang near matches together.

### Common Wallpaper and Wall Covering Problems | DoItYourself.com

Use Polycell Overlap & Repair Adhesive in a tube. Remember to wipe away any excess adhesive squeezed out when the wallpaper is pressed back into place. If the wallpaper is thick or heavily curled, it pays to wet it with a sponge - this makes it more flexible and easier to work with.

### What is the best way of sticking back loose wallpaper or ...

The Fix: Wallpaper edges curling up at the seam could be the result of not applying enough adhesive when pasting. Take deep breaths and deal with it in a couple of easy steps. Start by dampening the area with warm water. Carefully lift the edge and apply wallpaper adhesive under it.

### How to fix mistakes when hanging wallpaper | Lick

For larger areas, another strip of sticky tape should be applied to the middle, too. The wallpaper strip is then pressed on from the top via the sides and the middle to the bottom, all the while checking for creases and air bubbles. In order to achieve this, the strip of wallpaper is constantly smoothed out.
