How to Read OBD1 Codes at Home Our method of reading the codes without a diagnostic tool is to make a “short” between pin A and pin B. The car will then enter the diagnostic mode and will flash the “ check engine Light ” several times and we should count the flashes to see the diagnostic codes. How to read the codes:
